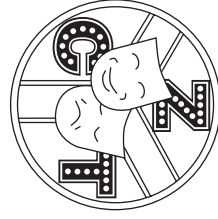

We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit.

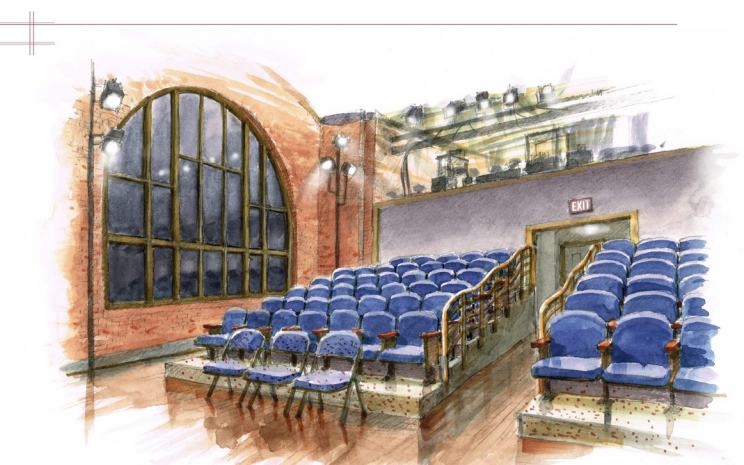
